Seven members of CAC Youth Corps graduated from the program in May after becoming California registered weatherization installers. The participants received training by CAC's Energy Services staff in the basics of weatherization installation as well as OSHA training to recognize and prevent hazards on the work site. The

final stage of training took pace in Stockton, CA. Youth Corps members learned to work with combustion appliances and identify fuel leaks and health hazards to the occupants of the homes. We are very proud to say that all of the Youth Corps participants passed and are now California registered weatherization installers. Healthy Senior Lunch provides hot nutritious meals to 300 seniors per day at community centers from Guadalupe to Carpinteria. We also deliver meals to 350 home bound seniors each day.
